

3. A National Merit Ranking (All India Rank) has been arrived based on the Marks secured against Total Marks. In case total marks are same for more than one candidate, the ranking has been done on sectional score considered in the order of :- Quantitative Techniques & Data Interpretation, Logical Reasoning, Language Comprehension, General Awareness and Candidate older in age.

programs along with the other criteria that may exist, as applicable.
