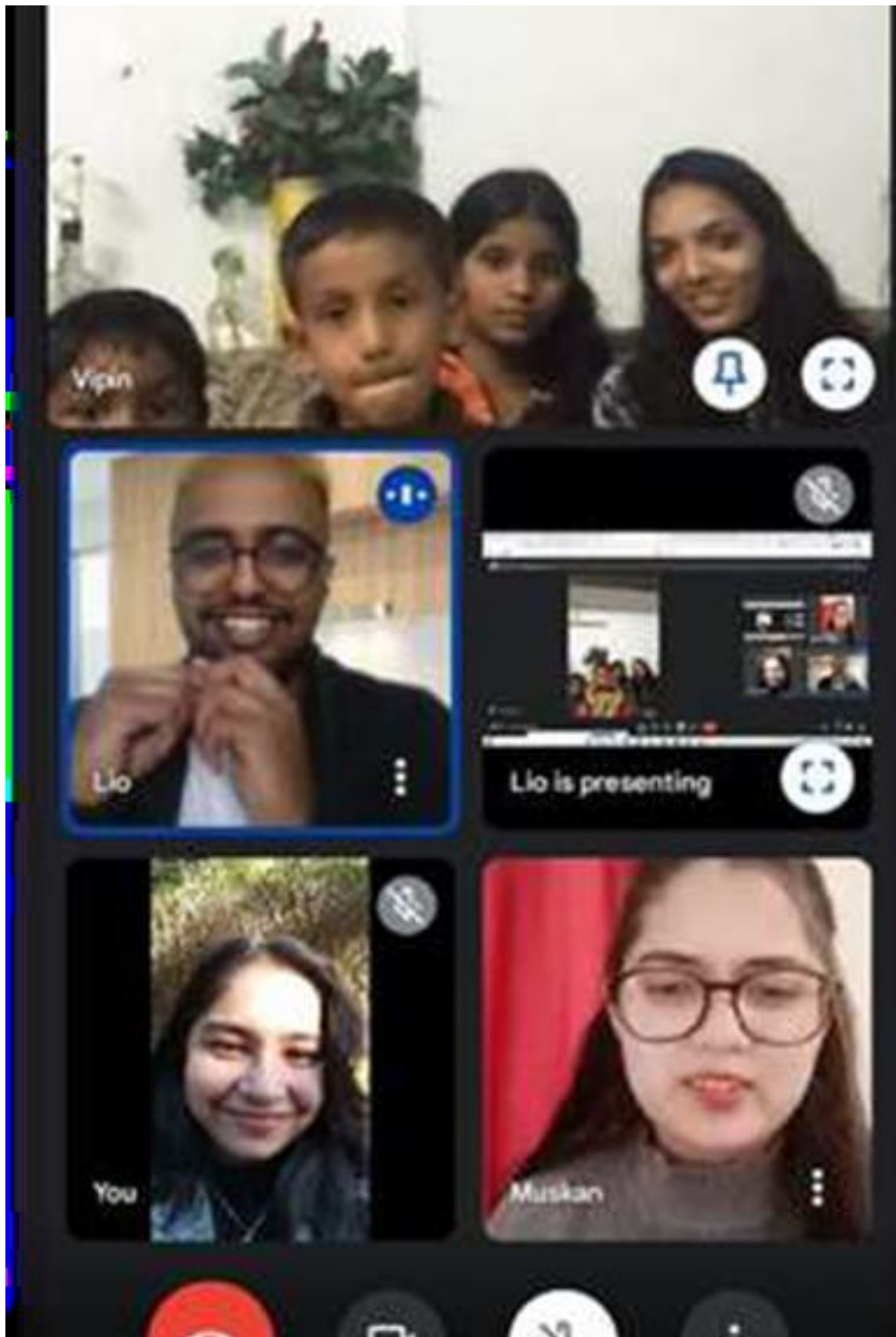
**Online education for underprivileged students at Mahadevi Library**

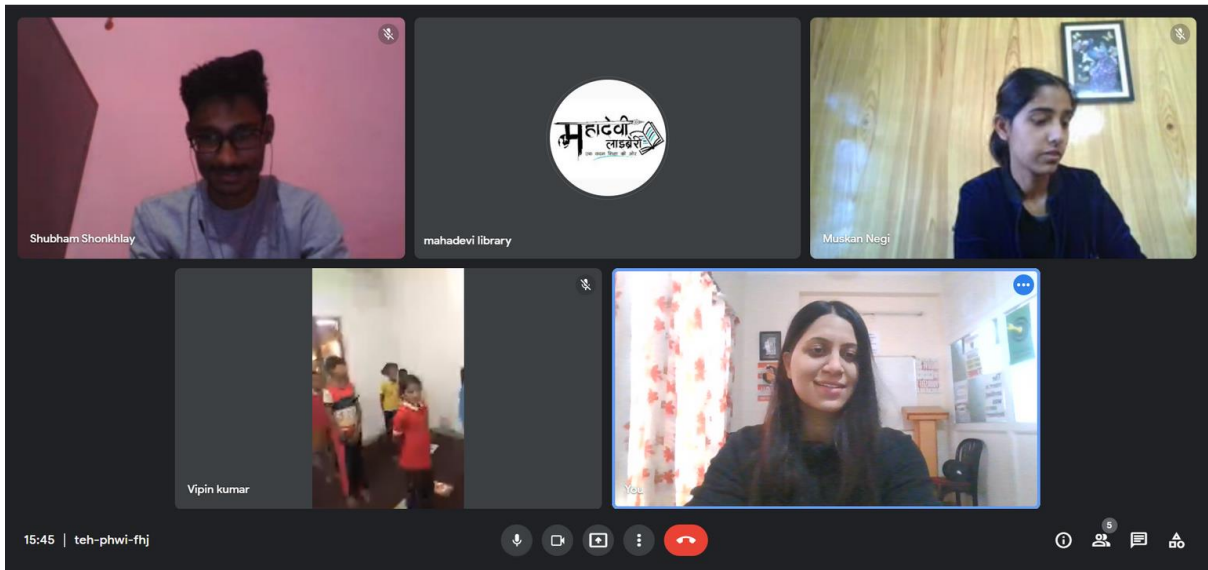

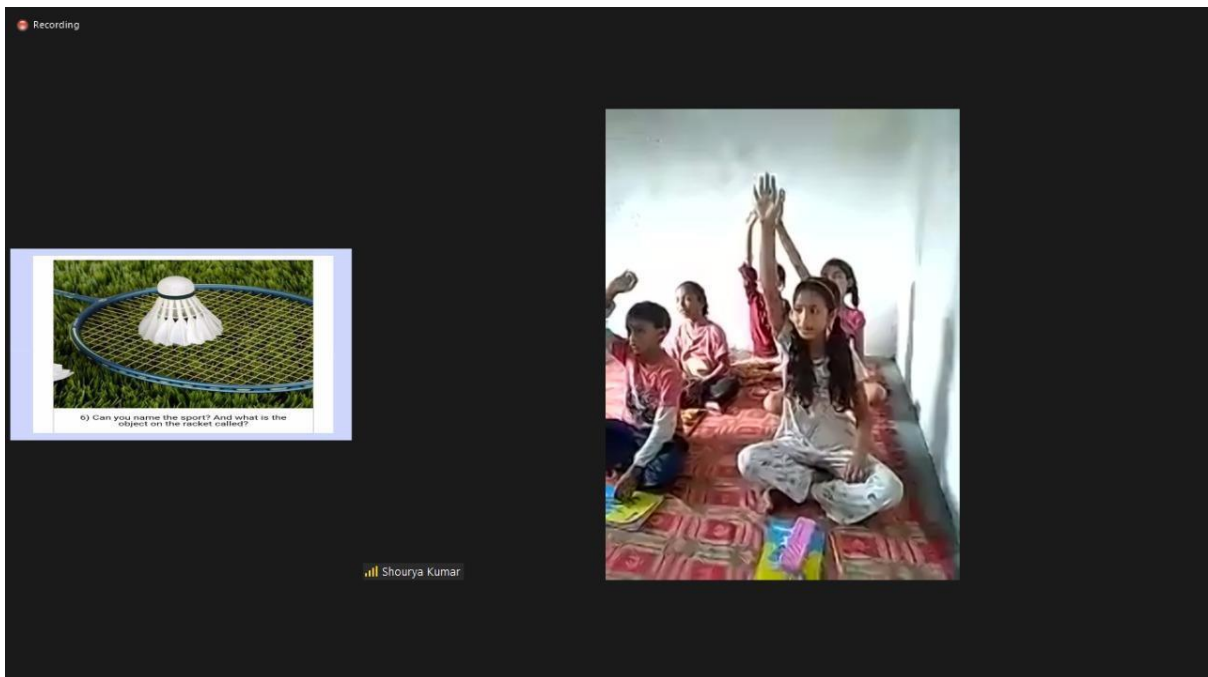
