BETWEEN

SHOOLINI UNIVERSITY OF BIOTECHNOLOGY AND MANAGEMENT SCIENCES situated at Bajhol, Solan 173229 Himachal Pradesh, a Private University recognized by UGC established under Private Universities act of Himachal Pradesh through its Vice Chancellor Prof. Atul Khosla (hereinafter called as "*SHOOLINI*" or *Party I*), which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns of the First Part.

AND

JINDAL INSTITUTE OF BEHAVIOURAL SCIENCES (JIBS), situated at Sonipat- 131001, Haryana, a value-based research institute of O.P Jindal Global Institution of Eminence Deemed to be University through its Principal Director Professor (Dr.) Sanjeev P. Sahni, (hereinafter called as "*JIBS*" or *Party II*) which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns of the Other Part.

WHEREAS both the parties jointly hereinafter shall be referred to as the Parties and individually as the Party.

WHEREAS SHOOLINI and JIBS mutually agree to cooperate on research and student engagement programs based on the principles of reciprocity.

OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU

1. That the main Objective of this MOU is to set up a center for research named "**Centre for Financial Crime Studies**"
2. That this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) encourages the exchange of academic information and materials in the belief that **the research and educational processes** at both the institutions will be enhanced with the mutual understanding between their respective faculty, scholars, and students by the establishment of such exchanges.
3. That both the parties will work in coordination to
 - a. Research in the area of financial crimes in India and abroad.
 - b. That both the parties agree on the collaborative research in the area of expertise.

- c. That both the parties will exchange academic Information and material.
- d. That both the parties will work Jointly organize programs like Seminars, Conferences, Workshops, FDP's on topic(s) of mutual interest.
- e. That both the parties will work towards development of IPR in Financial Crimes and both share the results of the same.
- f. That both the parties will allow students of BALLB, LLM and PhD on reciprocal basis for a limited period for library consultation, guidance from faculty members and research.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The implementation of each specific exchange based on this MOU shall be separately negotiated and determined by both the Institutions. This MOU being non-financial in nature, both parties shall be responsible to find respective financial sources for carrying out the exchange programs.
2. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will any constraints or financial obligations be imposed by upon the other in carrying out the MOU.
3. This MOU shall be in force for Three Years and is subject to revision or modification by mutual written consent. It is also understood that either institution may terminate the MOU at any time, although such action will only be taken after mutual consultation and consent in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to all parties. This MOU shall take effect from the date of the latest signature below.
