EDUCATIONAL PARTNERSHIP ADMINISTRATION

PREAMBLE

Kateb University and Shoolini University hereby agree to work together by sharing academic resources and experiences to improve access to quality educational opportunities at Kateb University in Afghanistan and Shoolini University in India and improve strength of the academic and administration staff in Afghanistan and India.

The objective of this agreement is to develop reciprocal development between Kateb University and Shoolini University.

The agreement will establish the conditions for an educational partnership based on a sustainable model of knowledge.

Kateb University hereafter called (KU) located in Darull-Aman Road, Kabul, Afghanistan and Shoolini University(SU) located Solan-Oachghat-Kumarhatti Highway, Bajhol, Himachal Pradesh 173229 have agreed upon the general terms and conditions in accordance with mutual desire for cooperation and collaboration aimed at improving, strengthening and promoting relations between

- 3.10. Exchanging research and educational data, where possible, to be used for education, research and training purposes.

Article 4. Visits and Other Possible Cooperation

Specific details of collaboration between the two universities, including topics of common activities and formalities concerning visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation, will be defined by mutual agreement in 'Agreements of cooperation' which will be prepared by authorized official representatives of the faculties/departments at both institutions who wish to collaborate under the framework of this agreement.

Article 5.

This agreement is written and signed in English in two copies. The present agreement will come into force as soon as it has been signed by the authorized representatives of the two institutions and will remain in force for a five- year period from the date of execution and may be renewed for an additional five-years upon mutual consent. The agreement may be terminated by the authorized official representative of either of either institutions by written notice. Such notice must be given at least three months before it becomes effective. Such termination shall not affect the completion of any activity underway at the time or the rights of individuals exchanged under this agreement, prior to the notice of termination.


Article 6:

Condition and Duration of MoU

1. Duration of this MoU will be for five years. Any party can terminate the MoU. The party, who decides to terminate the MoU, must notify the other parties in writing of its decision to terminate the MoU.
2. For better coordination between the parties, each party will introduce a person as a focal point to coordinate between Kateb and Shoolini University.

SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

Areas of collaboration may be proposed by either institution and may include, but are not limited to:

Article 1. Providing Technical Support

- 1.1. Expertise Sharing to enhance the Administrative, Organizational, Academic, and Research Development at both institutions
- 1.2. Providing technical support based on experience for publishing research papers based on impact factor journals
- 1.3. Providing technical support in the areas of development projects and programs
- 1.4. Providing technical support in Research and Development (R&D) Projects
- 1.5. Providing technical support through faculty exchanges
- 1.6. Providing technical support in customization of educational technologies within both universities

Article 2. Resource and Technology Sharing

- 2.1. Resource Sharing (Digital Library, Journals, Policies, Procedures, ToRs, Standards, Lesson Learnt)
- 2.2. Technology Sharing (LMS, MIS, E-Learning, Financial ERP, Academic and Applied Research Management System, Technology for simulation centers in the field of medicine, computer science, and engineering)

Article 3. Trainings and Development Programs

- 3.1. Promoting and encouraging the exchange of academic and administration staff and students for short and long term visits and fellowships
- 3.2. Providing Professional Trainings for use of LMS at KU and SU.
- 3.3. Facilitating and exchanging invitations to scholars and Students for professional trainings and academic activities
- 3.4. Developing the Capacity of Faculty in the areas of Teaching Methods and Research Methods
- 3.5. Conducting Academic and Scientific Conferences
- 3.6. Initiating Joint Training and Development Projects for Afghanistan, India and Region
- 3.7. Facilitating Joint Academic and Applied Researches in fields of common interest
- 3.8. Exploring the establishment of joint degree (Masters and Ph.D. programs) between interested departments of both institutions.
- 3.9. Establishing Joint Venture in R&D Projects in Afghanistan and India.
