AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION IN EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT

Between

1. Shoolini University of Biotechnology and Management Sciences (SUBMS), Bajhol, Solan
2. Shoolini Institute of Life Sciences & Business Management, Solan.

Preamble

Shoolini University of Biotechnology and Management Sciences and Shoolini Institute of Life Sciences & Business Management expressed their wish to co-operative in areas of mutual interest in order to increase their activities in education, academic exchange, research, technical support, and placement process. To that effect, the representatives of both parties hereby close the following Agreement of co- operation:

Article 1

- 1.1 The co-operation between the institutions signed below will consist of the
 - 1.1.1 Exchange of academic staff as and when required,
 - 1.1.2 Researchers and students and co-operative projects in education,
 - 1.1.3 Research and development and technology transfer on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
 - 1.1.4 Technology sharing in relation to online Learning Platform (LMS).
 - 1.1.5 Online attendance platform which is developed in house by the University.
 - 1.1.6 Online library services platform which is also developed in -- house university.
 - 1.1.7 Support in application of various accreditation bodies & developing strategies for quality enhancement, improvement, and sustenance.



1.1.8 Support in placement process of the Institute Students.

1.1.9 Support in foreign collaboration of the Institute.

1.1.10 Any technical Support required for patent filing and legal issues.

Article 1

1.2 With respect to concrete projects, plans or programs the implementations of the present agreement shall be supported and further developed by closing partial contracts between the Faculties, Institutes and Departments of the respective institutions.

Article 2

2.1 The outcome of mutually executed research projects shall form common property of both the Institutes which may be in the form of courses developed, Papers published and patents field. The credit shall be shared in a manner mutually agreed by both the Institutes.

Article 3

3.1 The visiting students / scientists shall be provided access to the respective libraries.

Article 4

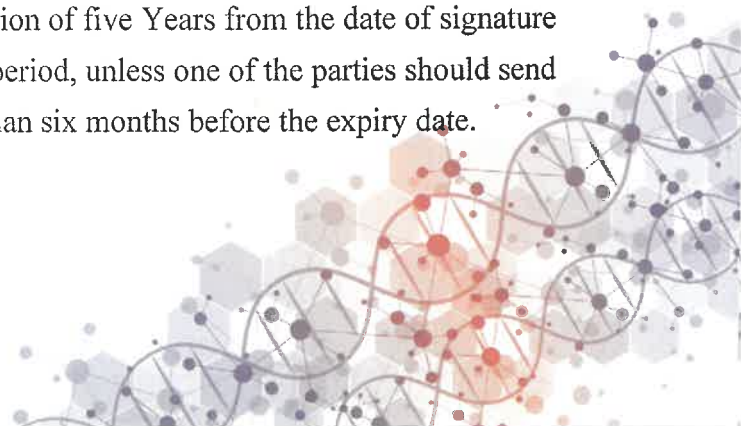
4.1 Nothing in this Agreement should be interpreted as contrary to existing agreements between these organizations and other institutions.

Article 5

5.1 Will come into force from the date of Agreement in writing from both sides and accepted in full faith by both the parties.

Article 6

6.1 The present Agreement is closed for the duration of five Years from the date of signature by both parties. It shall be renewed for the same period, unless one of the parties should send a written termination of the Agreement no later than six months before the expiry date.



Article 7

7.1 Nothing in this Agreement shall constitute financial obligations with respect to either of the contractual parties.

7.2 Both Parties agree that no obligation shall be incumbent to them in any case of death, injury, or damages caused to persons or property which may have occurred in the course of the implementation period of a collaborative project.

7.3 The contract shall be signed in two copies. Each institution will keep copy of the signed agreement.
