Subject: Official Sanction of Scholarships and Freeships Program for AY 2022-23

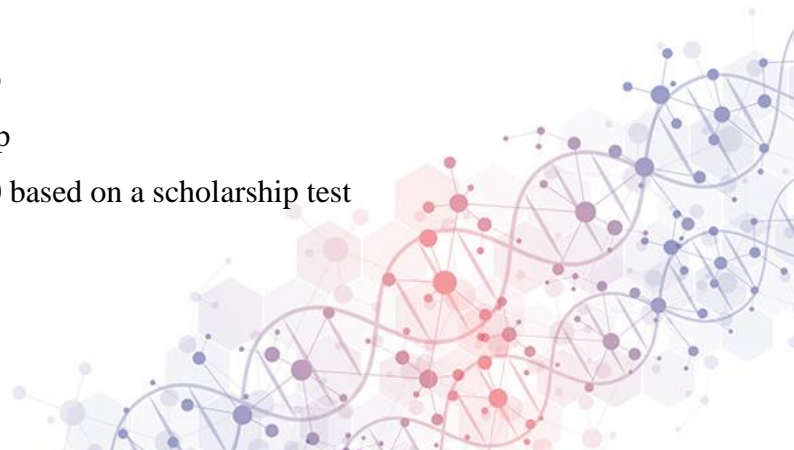
Dear Head - Admission,

 - A one-time award of Rs. 50,000 based on a scholarship test

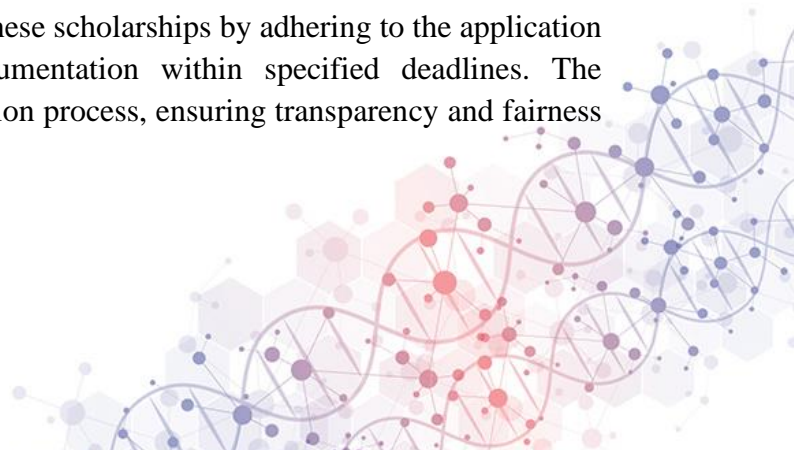
